Studies, SPED, History, Geography, Geology, AEIS, Humanities, Art History, Linguistics, Ethnic Studies, Biology Tutor students in content areas, academic processes, and time management skills.</p> <p>Work in conjunction with the SSA staff in communicating and documenting student progress to academic advisors, learning specialists, and athletic department personnel. Attend mandatory tutor training meetings with the SSA Learning Specialists. The ideal candidate is a graduate student with previous tutoring experience (at least one year) and also has an above average knowledge of the subject they are wishing to tutor. Undergraduates with these same qualifications will be considered as long as they hold a junior or senior status. Qualified candidates will have attained at least junior standing, a cumulative 3.0 GPA, have good communication and interpersonal skills, and have detailed knowledge of a specific subject area and/or a broad knowledge of many general education areas.</p> <p>Our tutors facilitate required and voluntary educational sessions with individuals and small groups of students. Tutors facilitate study groups and midterm and final exam review groups in their areas of expertise when appropriate. Tutors have regular weekly meetings with targeted students, such as freshmen and students in academic jeopardy (low GPA). In addition, tutors are available for student athletes who come in voluntarily, as well as drop-ins.</p> <p>Tutors are required to maintain records for all appointments through an online reporting system. Tutors are responsible for keeping their appointments and study sessions quiet and learning-focused. If scheduled accordingly, tutors will be expected to aid with opening and closing procedures. Tutors will participate in training sessions throughout the year, and work closely with the staff and other tutors as part of an interactive team. Last, tutors are expected to be proactive in communicating with the Learning Specialists and Advisors about scheduling, tutoring, and student related matters. They also need to be flexible to schedule changes and have an availability of at least 10 hours per week.</p>
